The Madison County Board of Commissioners met in joint session with the Madison County Board of Education on Monday, November 30, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in Room#26 of the County Administration Building, Marshall, NC.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

In attendance were Chairman Wayne Brigman, Vice-Chairman Clayton Rice, Commissioner Bill Briggs, Commissioner Norris Gentry, Commissioner Matthew Wechtel, and County Manager Forrest Gilliam.

The Boards jointly discussed the proposed school building program and financing as well as properties owned by the Board of Commissioners and the Board of Education.

The Board of Education adjourned.

Upon motion by Commissioner Rice, seconded by Commissioner Gentry, the Board voted unanimously to enter into closed session to discuss personnel and matters of attorney-client privilege.

Upon motion by Commissioner Rice, seconded by Commissioner Gentry, the Board voted unanimously to return to open session.

Upon motion by Commissioner Rice, seconded by Commissioner Wechtel, the Board voted unanimously to employ Sarah Nichols in the position of County Planner in the Inspections and Zoning Department at a salary of \$43,000. Ms. Nichols will transfer from her role with the Soil and Water Conservation District until there has been reasonable time to find her replacement.

Upon motion by Commissioner Gentry, seconded by Commissioner Wechtel, the Board voted unanimously to employ Dewayne Grindstaff as a Nutrition Driver in the Community Services Department.

Upon motion by Commissioner Rice, seconded by Commissioner Gentry, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.
