

The Madison County Board of Commissioners met in special session on Friday, March 7, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. at the Madison County Public Library Conference Room, Marshall Branch, 1335 N. Main Street, Marshall, NC.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m.

I.

Ryan Cody, Building Inspector, appeared before the Board to discuss proposed changes to the Land Use Ordinance of Madison County.

II.

Alan Hunter, Maintenance Director, appeared before the Board to discuss the possibility of obtaining one additional person from Craggy Correctional Center through the work release program.

III.

Jim Huff, Landfill Director, appeared before the Board to discuss the purchase of a Unimog from the State Surplus Agency and how the equipment would be beneficial to the operations of the landfill.

IV.

Bailey Mundy, Soil Conservation Director, appeared before the Board to discuss grant funding sources related to Barnard Park. Also, discussed was the sale of the property housing the Soil Conservation Office and the need for employment of a part time person in his office.

The Board held a discussion on items relating to the Ebbs Chapel Community Center including the 2008 Rural Economic Development Center Grant in the amount of \$75,000.00.
