Description of Work:

The Madison County Health Department (MCHD) has an opening for a Public Health Nurse II to serve as a school nurse for the Madison County School district. The school nurse serves in the role of case manager, direct care provider, collaborator/advocate, educator, and counselor in assigned schools and would be available to assist the MCHD during a public health emergency and with other activities as needed.

Minimum Education and Experience:

Graduation from a four-year college or university with a B.S. in Nursing which includes a Public Health Nursing rotation and one year of Public Health Nursing experience; or Master's in Public Health and graduation from a school of professional nursing and one year of professional nursing experience; or graduation from a school of professional nursing and two years of professional nursing experience including one year of Public Health Nursing experience; or an equivalent combination of training and experience.

Necessary Special Qualifications - A current license to practice as a Registered Nurse in North Carolina by the N. C. Board of Nursing.

Resumes will not be accepted without the completed application. Application must include a summary of job duties performed and work experience. "See resume" on application is not acceptable. We will need a copy of transcripts.
